

WHAT: National Trails Day Hike on June 6, 2026 at 8:30 AM

WHERE: Clear Creek Trail in Cimarron Canyon. Meet at the trailhead near Mile Marker 292 on Highway 292 in Cimarron Canyon. No fee for the hike, but All NM State Park regulations apply regarding parking and Park access fees.

CLEAR CREEK TRAIL INFO: Moderate to moderately difficult - see pictures and more info at link <https://www.onlyinyourstate.com/nature/new-mexico/clear-creek-trail-waterfall-nm>

- Distance: About 4-miles round trip passing three waterfalls.
- Participants don't have to hike to the end unless they want to see the 3rd waterfall.
- Elevation Gain: 800 ft.
- Hiking Trail follows Clear Creek and crosses several makeshift log bridges.
- A short section of the trail is steep and narrow.
- The trail ends at the third waterfall and returns along the same route.
- Participants aren't required to go to the end of the trail and can determine when they will return to the trailhead as the trail is up and back on the same path.
- Basically, going out is uphill and returning is downhill.
- Dress appropriate for outdoor weather conditions.
- Bring water and a snack for yourself.
- A walking/hiking stick is helpful, especially for the steep section.
- Those planning to participate should text their name and the number in their party to: 469-293-3397.
- Meet at the trailhead at 8:30 AM.
- To save time registering at the trailhead, please complete and bring the attached Waiver and Release form for each member of your group.
